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REGULATORY DECISION OF THE 253rd AUTHORITY MEETING

The Authority, at its 253rd Meeting held on Friday 2nd October 2015, at Golf Course Hotel Kampala, upon consideration and taking into account the information availed to it in respect of the following matters, **RESOLVED** inter alia as follows:-

THE APPLICATION FOR LICENSE BY SUGAR AND ALLIED INDUSTRIES LIMITED (SAIL) FOR A 11.9 MW BAGASSE CO-GENERATION PLANT, IN KALIRO DISTRICT

On 11th April 2014, Sugar and Allied Industries Limited (SAIL) submitted a License application for the generation and sale of electricity from the established 11.9 MW bagasse co-generation power plant located in Bwayuya village, Kaliro District.

SAIL intended to consume 5.0 MW internally for the sugar production processes and sell the excess 6.9 MW to Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited (UETCL) through the National Grid.

It was observed that construction of the power plant and the sugar plant was completed in September 2013 and both plants were commissioned on 4th October 2013 and the plant was generating 11.9 MW of electricity for its own use in the sugar production processes.

On 11th September 2015, SAIL submitted all the information in relation to the license application having addressed the outstanding issues to the satisfaction of the Authority.

Accordingly, the Authority approved the issuance of a license for generation and sale of electricity to Sugar and Allied Industries Limited for the existing 11.9 MW bagasse co-generation power plant located in Bwayuya village, Kaliro District for own use (**5.0 MW**) and sell to the National Grid (**6.9 MW**), subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) A license term of 20 years and;
- (ii) A levelized tariff of US\$0.095/kWh for the license term.
